HCE Policy Corner



Arrival Times:

Students may enter the classrooms at 7:50 a.m.

Students in grades K-2 arriving before 7:50 a.m. will wait in the cafeteria and students in grades 3-5 will wait in the gym where staff members will supervise students in both locations. Students may not arrive before 7:30 a.m. since there is no one available to supervise them. At 7:50 a.m. students in both locations are lined up and dismissed to their classrooms.

Afternoon Dismissal:

The end of the school day is a busy time for teachers and students. If you are picking your child up after school we ask that you wait for your child in the carpool line for parent pick up or by the flagpole in front of the school for walkers. Please do not wait for your child outside the classroom door. Your child will be walked by a teacher to meet you at the designated spot. Thank you for helping to make dismissal time a smooth transition for students and teachers.

Changes in your child's method of afterschool dismissal:

If there is a planned change in your child's usual method of going home, send a dated and signed note to your child's teacher. This note should specifically state how your child will be going home that day. If your child will be going home with another student, that student's parent must also send a note.

If your child regularly attends a Day Care program after school and a change is needed, contact the Day Care to inform them of the change as well.

Students will be expected to follow the regular way for going home unless a written note is sent by a parent.

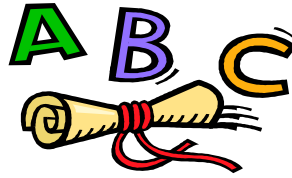

Campus School Health Advisory Committee

A critical aspect of our job is to empower children, through education, about healthy lifestyle choices, as they relate to food consumption. Our Campus School Health Advisory Committee (CSHAC) is committed to this particular area of Child development. Of particular note is the area of food intake in the cafeteria by students. We incorporate the following measures in our cafeteria:

- * Children will be encouraged to eat more fruits and vegetables on a daily basis.
- * Children will only be served one main course entrée. If a child reports that he/she would like additional food to consume, we will allow them to buy additional fruits and vegetables.

Finally, we will also begin to communicate more regularly with our students about the notion of "GO- FOODS, SLOW- FOODS and NO-FOODS. These 3 categories identify foods that are always acceptable to eat; those foods that are best consumed in moderation; and those foods that are best avoided for a healthy lifestyle! First of all what is it? The Odyssey of the Mind teaches students how to think divergently by providing open-ended problems that appeal to a wide range of interests. Students learn how to identify challenges and to think creatively to solve those problems. They are free to express their ideas and suggestions without fear of criticism. It is the largest creative problem-solving competition in the world where 5-7 students work together all year on a team with a coach to solve one of five problems listed below. The program is for grades kindergarten through college. The problems range from technical, humorous, vehicular, classical to engineering. View the problems at www.odysseyofthemind.com and click problem synopsis.

Secondly, who coaches and how? Each student team of 5 – 7 students must have a coach. You don't have to know anything about the students problem because you are not allowed to help at all anyway. Spring Branch has plenty of coach support.

Problem 1: Ooh-Motional Vehicle

Divisions I, II, & III

The problem requires teams to design, build, and drive a vehicle that will travel a course where it will encounter three different situations. The vehicle will display a different human emotion for each encounter and one will cause it to travel in reverse. The emphases will be on the technical risk-taking and creativity of the vehicle's engineering and change of emotional appearance.

Problem 2: Weird Science

Divisions I, II, III, & IV

The team will create and present a performance about a team of scientists on an expedition to uncover the cause of mysterious events. The team will select the location of the expedition from NASA Earth Observatory Photographs . The scientists will collect two samples and will report on their findings. It will include a technical representation, a moving backdrop and a team-created device.

Problem 3: To Be or Not To Be

Divisions I, II, III & IV

In this Classics problem, teams will put a musical theatre spin on one of William Shakespeare's most famous lines: "To Be Or Not To Be." Hamlet, the title character, ponders this question and realizes that the easy way out is not always the correct choice. An original "Hamlet" character will face a team-created dilemma and will take the easy way out only to discover that it was the wrong choice.

Problem 4: You Make the Call

Divisions I, II, III & IV

For this problem, teams will design and build a structure made of only balsa wood and glue that will balance and support as much weight as possible. The structure may have a maximum weight of 9 grams and will receive 2 times the weight held, or 12 grams and receive 1 ½ times the weight held, or 15 grams and receive the actual weight held. The testing

Problem 5: Odyssey Angels

Divisions I, II, III & IV

The team will create and present a performance where a group of students travel throughout one or more team-created places where they encounter negative situations. These "Odyssey Angels" change what they find and turn them into positive situations. On their journey, they help two individuals with different problems and help save an entire community from a bad situation. One Odyssey Angel cannot speak, and another has a special team-created power.

Primary: Hide and Peek

Grades K-2

The team is to create a device that uncovers three surprise objects by lifting a team-decorated container off of each of them from 5, 8 and 10 feet away. The containers may be raised at any time, in any order, and may be raised simultaneously.

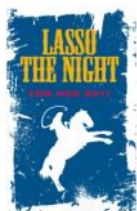

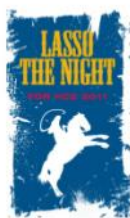
